Baumann Sawmill Field Trip Wednesday, April 19th

Join the members of the Norfolk Woodlot Owners Association on a day trip to the Baumann Sawmill located in Wallenstein (30 minutes north of Kitchener), the heart of Mennonite farming country. Baumann Sawmill is a unique business in southern Ontario offering services in tree marking under Good Forestry Practises, woodlot management planning, Forest Stewardship Council Certification, and outreach to woodlot owners looking for expert advice. Baumann Sawmill produces various lumber products and millwork, as well as finished products, most notably their line of classic sleighs sold in stores across Canada. Their commitment to sustainable forestry practises and biodiversity is impressive and their slogan says it all "From Forest Management to Finished Product".

The trip is open to NWOA members whose membership fees are in good standing. The full cost of transportation is \$35.00 per person however; the NWOA will partially cover the transportation. Round trip transportation will be \$20.00 per person. Participants can pay by cash or cheque. We will meet in the north east section of the parking lot at the Delhi German Hall (443 James St, Delhi). The bus will leave the parking lot at 8:30 am sharp and will return by 4 pm.

We will stop at The Crossroads in Elmira for a buffet lunch (lunch not provided by NWOA).



In Memory Of Harry Barrett

Norfolk County has lost its chief storyteller and one of its most important historians and conservationists.

Harry B. Barrett's life was one of learning and adventure – experiences he put to paper that became important books.

From his time in the navy during World War II to his interest in local wildlife painter William Pope and especially local history, Barrett was prolific, publishing 16 books on all these topics and more, even into his late 80s.



Barrett, who died January 26, age 94, was also influential in agriculture, education and preserving the environment.

He helped establish the Long Point World Biosphere, which advocates preserving the natural features of the area, taught agriculture at area high schools, and started the farm management program at Simcoe's Fanshawe College.

Barrett's sense of adventure started when he was a child growing up on the family farm north of Port Dover.
